

# Light-catcher Crafts

One of the best things about tissue paper is the way it catches the light. Why not make some great shine-through crafts with Hello Kitty and Rory?

## Hello Kitty Lamp Hanger:

Rory has a cool stained-glass craft that looks just like his friend Hello Kitty. He hangs it near his lamp where he can see it every night. It reminds him of his special friendship with Hello Kitty!

### What You Need:

- Pencil
- White tracing paper
- Pen
- Black construction paper
- Scissors
- Craft knife
- Glue
- Tissue paper (red, white, yellow, and blue)
- String
- Tape

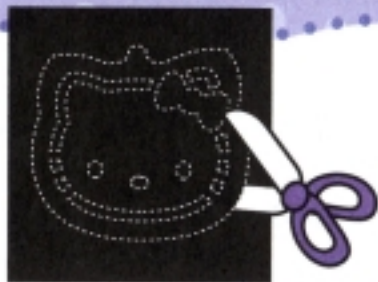
### What You Do:

1. Trace the Hello Kitty shape from page 41 onto a piece of white tracing paper.

2. Set the white tracing paper onto a piece of black construction paper. Draw over the lines of the pattern with a pen. Press hard enough so that you leave dents in the black paper underneath.



**3.** Cut along the dents you left in the black paper. (Ask a grown-up to cut out the holes for Hello Kitty's eyes and nose with a craft knife.)

**4.** Lay the black paper on a table with the bow on the left side. Spread a little glue around the edges of each cutout hole. Then stick tissue paper over the holes. Put red tissue paper over Hello Kitty's bow, white tissue paper over Hello Kitty's eyes, yellow tissue paper over Hello Kitty's nose, and blue tissue paper all around Hello Kitty's face.

**5.** Flip the cutout over and poke a hole through the bump at the top of the lamp hanger, as shown.



**6.** Tie a loop of string through the hole. Use a little piece of tape to attach the loop to the edge of a lampshade. Turn on the lamp and enjoy the colors!
